> Sports cars again at Put in Bay June 29 – July 1, 2009

Right after the SVRA Mid-Ohio Vintage Race, Saturday June 27 and Sunday June 28, about twenty of the competing cars will go up to Putin-Bay. They'll be there from Monday June 29th through Wednesday July 1st as part of a program put on by Sportscar Vintage Racing Association, which sanctions races primarily in the eastern states.
